Please bring any unmounted prints to the meetings on Monday 15 October or Monday 22 October. Prints mounted and framed can be accepted up to the morning of the hanging, Saturday 27 October, but **we need to know titles before then on this form**. We can make arrangements to collect prints if necessary. And we can deal with a few "late" unmounted prints.

Hanging is on **Saturday 27 October from 10 am**. The more volunteers the merrier!

As in previous years, we will have a "hayrack" where other (unframed but mounted) prints you may wish to sell can be viewed. We suggest they are priced and, ideally, protected with florists cellophane or similar. All the proceeds from the hayrack go to Katharine House Hospice. As in 2017, we will also be selling members' greetings cards in aid of Katharine House.
